

The idea for a Pybus Kids Century started in August 2013 by a small group of local moms and active bicyclists here in the Wenatchee Valley. Very quickly the group developed three overall program goals:

- 1. Encourage and increase physical activity levels in the Wenatchee Valley with emphasis on youth.
- 2. Increase bicycle safety awareness and improve trail etiquette.
- 3. Increase family biking comfort levels on all bike facility types throughout the Wenatchee Valley.

The 2014 Pybus Kids Century will will be open from May1-October 31, 2014. This program is for area youth ages 6-14. Families can register their children during one of the registration events (schedule/information to follow) or anytime during the the event timeline at Pybus Market.

Every time a child rides the loop they receive a stamp on their loop tally card. Parents will be instructed where to report each loop ride. Prizes are awarded for accomplishing Pybus Half Century (5 loops/50 miles) and Pybus Full Century (10 loops/100 miles).

In September-October 2013, 67 youth road a total of 1350 miles during the Pybus Kids Century. This equated to nearly 106 hours of exercise!! Let's see how many miles can be tallied in 2014!!
