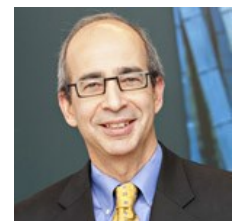

Zackery Lystedt & Parents

All 50 states now have a youth concussion law and most were based on Washington's 2009 Lystedt Law.

Richard H. Adler is the principal of Adler Giersch ps, a law firm known for its legal expertise in the area of traumatic brain and spinal injuries. Mr. Adler's advocacy led to Washington's first-in-the-nation law aimed at preventing preventable brain injury in youth sports, known as the "Zackery Lystedt Law." Since then all 50 states have adopted the core principles of this law.
